We need your help ASAP to ensure that veterans are not left behind in the state's COVID Vaccine Incentive Program. For those unaware, the Newsom administration recently announced a program titled "Vax for the Win" – a cash lottery program that awards 10 vaccinated Californians \$1.5 million, and 30 vaccinated Californians \$50,000 if they've received or plan to receive at least one vaccination dose before June 15. However, veterans who were vaccinated at VA hospitals or military hospitals/installations are not registered with the state's immunization registry (CAIR) and therefore, not currently be eligible or entered into the lottery.

We are asking all of you to [use the CSCVC's online tool](#) to send a letter to the CalVet Secretary, urging that he address this oversight with Governor Newsom. Don't allow the state to neglect our veterans, their families, and VA healthcare workers. [Utilize the tool TODAY](#) to ensure that this oversight is corrected before June 15th.
